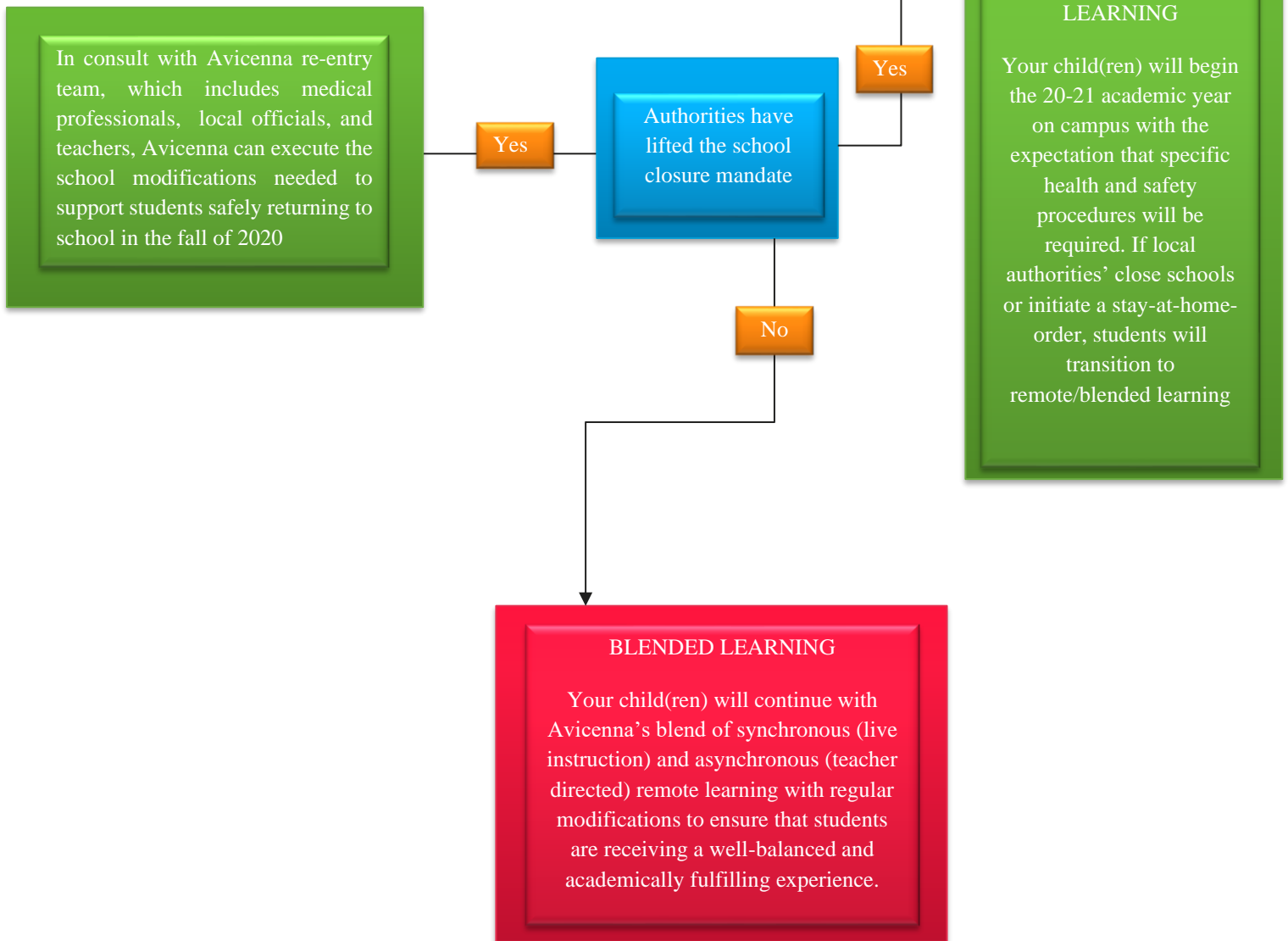

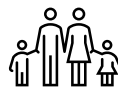

Updated as CDC/CDF Recommendations Evolve



Considerations for testing/health screenings for students, faculty, and staff before entering building



Parents and visitors will not be permitted in the building



Lunch will take place outside when weather permits or in classrooms – Pizza and snack sale provided through Avicenna office will be permitted on campus only



Families will be responsible for keeping a tracing log



Staggered schedule for drop-off and pick-up



The use of masks as mandated by health authority



Each student will be required to quarantine For two weeks prior to returning to campus and following illness



Modification to dress uniform due to increased time spent outside



Enhanced sanitizing and cleaning processes



Outdoor space will be utilized to its full potential for instructional and social purposes

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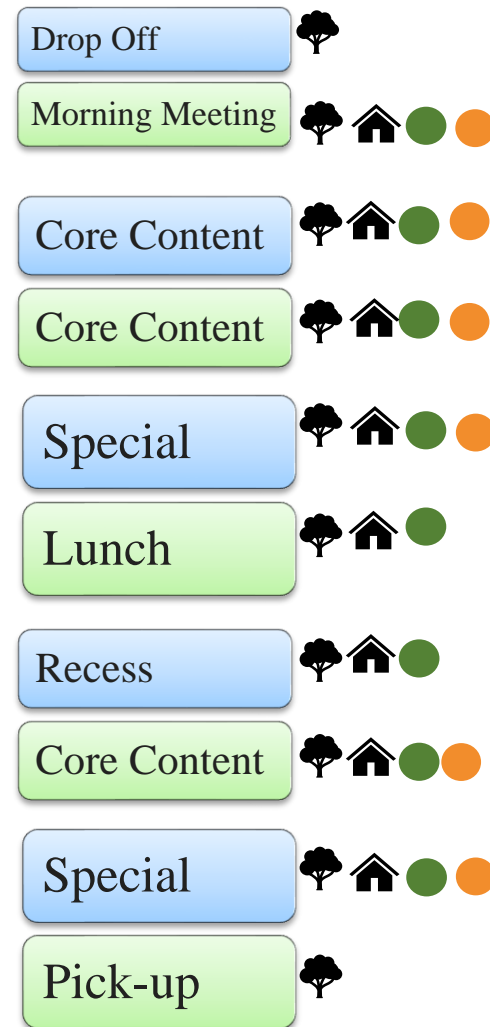

Structuring the School Day

As noted, the re-entry learning plan differ from the emergency remote learning plan in significant ways. The re-entry plan is designed for expected COVID waves where on-campus and off-campus learning can flow seamlessly.

Curriculum and projects are planned in 2-3-week modules with digital curriculum to accompany or supplement off-campus learning.

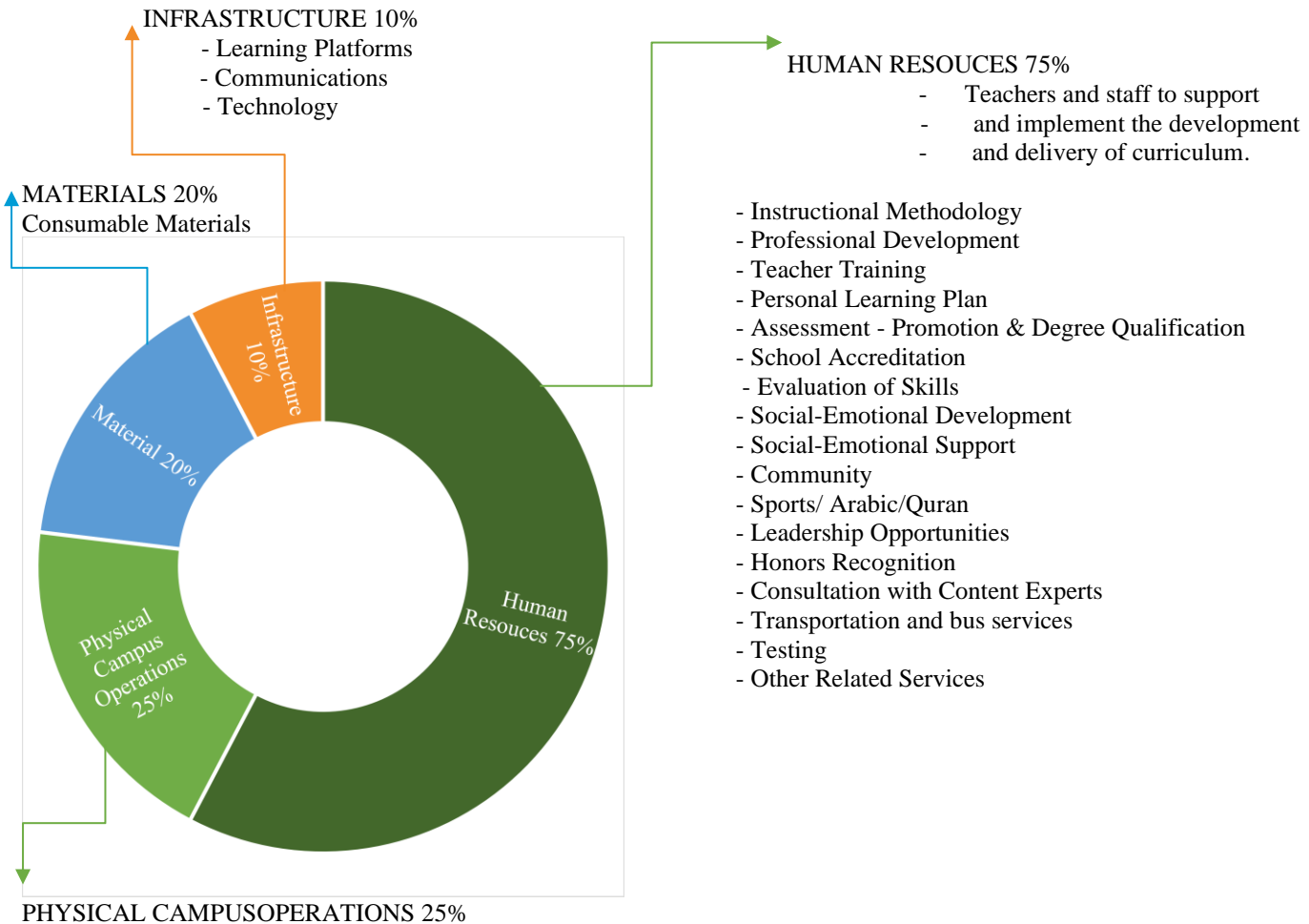

Gradelink will continue to be our school's main information system. Parents and students can access grades, calendars, school news, class announcements, and more.



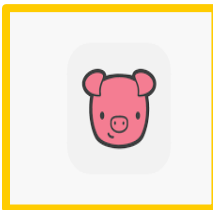
Google Meets will be one of Avicenna's primary platforms for LIVE (synchronous) instruction. Google Hangout/Meets can be joined directly from the calendar invite or class link sent from your teacher.



Google Classroom is somewhat to for Avicenna students in grades 4-12 and they are accustomed to managing their work, discussions, and assignments through this platform. All class assignments, videos, and announcements will be housed here.



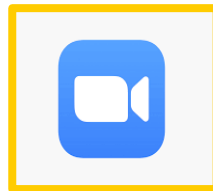
For students in Early Childhood – Grade 5, SeeSaw will be your online platform for viewing video lessons and uploading your student's documentation of work (pictures, videos, etc). Questions about SeeSaw should be directed to your child's teacher.



Avicenna is partnering this year with Freckles education by Renaissance which offer teachers, students, and parents all the tools necessary for success – a rigorous online curriculum.



For students in Early Childhood - Grade 6, Nearpod will be your online platform for viewing video lessons and uploading your student's documentation of work (pictures, videos, etc). Questions about Nearpod should be directed to your child's teacher.



Zoom is a video conferencing platform that can be used to provide LIVE (synchronous) virtual class meeting space like the Google Meets/Hangouts.



For students in middle school, Flipgrid will be your online platform for viewing video lessons and uploading your student's work (pictures, videos, etc). Questions about Flipgrid should be directed to your child's teacher.

Preparing for Interruptions

Following the recommendations from our re-entry team and trends from past pandemics, Avicenna is preparing for waves of interruption to in school learning. In the event of our local community experiences a spike in COVID-19 cases and an interruption of physical operations occurs, a shift to blended/remote learning will happen immediately.



If the school building closes and Avicenna transitions to blended and or online learning, tuition will be still paid in full as agreed upon on registration time.



Students will be equipped with a remote-learning tool in the event on-campus learning transitions to the blended model. Books and supplies will be readily accessible in the event an interruption occurs.



We recognize the needs of young children include the requirement of supervision and care in addition to their learning. In the event campus closes, we will prioritize the in-school experience for our youngest students.
